- 1) Competition Committee #8 from April 4
 - * Action Item from April 4, 2017 Comp Committee Meeting:
Region Bid Events that use the Power Pool format should make that intent known at the time of sanctioning. The Power Pool format will be further defined in the handbook and the tie-breaking procedure will be further defined for Power Pool formats. -Passes 4-0 (exact language pending)
- 2) Competition Committee #6 from April 4, 2017
 - * Action Item from April 4, 2017 Comp Committee Meeting:
 - *If the region should get into a situation where there are not enough referees to cover all of the competition courts for one weekend, the region will guarantee a certain number of courts per event but may not be able to guarantee more than that should more be required. Language for the handbook pending. – Passes 4-0*
 - *The Region Board has asked us if we can come up with a formula for Officials not guaranteed*
- 3) Competition Committee #9 from April 4, 2017
 - * Action Item from April 4, 2017 Comp Committee Meeting:
The handbook shall include a section clarifying the responsibilities of the clubs concerning game day rosters and other pre-tournament requirements. A checklist and 'how-to' presentation will be added as resources to the region website. -Passes 4-0
- 4) Should the NTR O&A (Offer & Acceptance) Form be Mandatory for clubs to use?
 - Request from Junior Board
- 5) Consider Forcing or Encouraging 4th in Pool in Open Bid to move to Club Division the next ranking tournament? - Request from Chris Finseth
- 6) USAV is offering a qualifying 11s division at GJNC in 2018, and the Region responsible for the 11s Bid process. Last year the Competition Committee offered as a solution to help with the 11s rankings to omit 11s division from MLK Bid Event. - Request from Junior Board
 - a) Our task is to recommend the best option to provide the best rankings for the 11s teams for the Bid Event in May.
 - b) Does this option include allowing MLK to have an 11s division this year?
 - c) Will having an 11s division of MLK have a negative consequence to the 11s Rankings?
 - d) Remember, 11s teams will still need to play in 12s division of National Qualifiers IF they want to play in a “qualifying” division.
- 7) This Committee is to recommend the 18s Regionals Bid Event date.
 - Annual Request per Junior Handbook
 - it may be too late by the time we meet to change this date
 - Currently the date March 17-18, 2018
- 8) Evaluate the Tournament Sanction process and the \$1,000 deposit as it pertains to Boys Tournaments. Can Tournament request for boys be less the \$1K?- Requested by Sherri Hausner
 - She says they hope or expect to have 20-25 boys teams at an event

- 9) Should the region Limit the number of tournament sanctions requested by a club in a year? - Requested by Nancy Siska

- 10) Proposal that teams who fail to advance at Bid Regionals, not be required to continue playing OR the tournament is only obligated to guarantee 6 Sets and 1 Day. – requested by Steve Hargrave

- 11) Are we having 'IF' Matches in the Silver Brackets? – requested by Eric Zender
